Our aim is to have a festival with no age limit and at any time of day or night. The festival's family-friendly areas will be adding new features. The Teen Yard opens a parkour area next to its skate park with high level guests and Magicomundo opens its climbing wall and connects with the musical universe of Zoo, the band of the moment. In between activities, there is a market with a wide range of proposals, an open-air restaurant area rich in world flavours, and time for collective reflection in the talks of the Social Forum, the Reggae University and Jamkunda, which completes its afternoons with Afro-modern dance.

nocturnal vibes

Six stages are activated at sunset in our reggae city to give way to a parade of sounds as eclectic as the Jamaican music itself that fills our hearts after the concerts kick off each evening on the Main Stage, so get ready. Discover the emerging talent on the Lion Stage. Dance to the rhythm of black roots music at Jumping and with the Afrobeats universe exported by the Afrobrunch and Follow The Party collectives at the new Jamkunda Stage. And to top it all off: dance to the early hours of the morning at the Dub Academy and the Dancehall stage, both with renewed designs.

+towards an emission-free future

We maintain our green philosophy, the plastic free seal and our commitment to renewable energies, recycling and efficient water use, but with new steps that bring us closer to the emission-neutral future we continue to work towards. Our 28th edition gets underway with good news: the AENOR certification of the festival's validated carbon footprint with which we complete the first part of the roadmap to identify the sources of greenhouse gases and calculate the volume of CO² generated, with the challenge of reducing and offsetting it.

With dialogue, coexistence, respect, union, empathy, truthful and contrasted information, commitment to the collective and care for what surrounds us, war will have a harder time and peace will have a smoother path.

United, we are going to project to the world that this experience of peace, tolerance and understanding that we give shape to every year is possible and necessary. That building a global movement against wars - all wars - and for peace is already on our horizon.

OUR BASE

Rototom Sunsplash is held in Benicassim (Castelló), at the Festival Venue located on the N-340 road, km, 986,300

VENUE OPENING HOURS

From 14:00 to 06:00 the next day.

CAMPING

The campsite located next to the venue is open 24 hours a day, from the 15th of August at 12:00 until the 23rd of August at 16:00. It has plots reserved for families and all kinds of services (showers, collective kitchens, laundry, market, left-luggage office).

You can stay here with your own tent or adapted vehicle, or book glamping accommodation. If you prefer another type of stay (hotel, airbnb), there is a wide offer in Benicàssim and nearby towns



PARKING

The festival has a **free parking** area next to the site. There are parking areas for people with disabilities and/or reduced mobility.

TICKET OFFICE

It will open on the 15th August at 12 noon and will be open 24 hours a day. From 16th to 21st August it will be open every day between 13:00 and 04:00. On the 22nd from 13:00 to 02:00

PRESALE TICKET OFFICE

Both people with disabilities and people over 65 will be able to get their free tickets in advance on Monday the 14th of August from 17:00 to 20:00 at the Rototom offices (Address: Calle Mossen Elías, 14, Benicàssim).

From Monday the 14th, to avoid gueues, the ticket office to exchange your advance ticket for the festival wristband will be open from 12:00 to 20:00. Other opening times on the website.

FAST LANE

The festival's ticket office has set up an exclusive window for disabled people to facilitate the process.

AIRPORT TRANSFER

Get to the festival comfortably from Valencia or Barcelona airport thanks to the Mediterraneo Holidays airport shuttle service.

Buy your bus ticket online. For the return, you can also purchase your transfer at the stall in front of the venue's ticket office.

BIKE OR BUS: GET AROUND IN ECO MODE

There are buses connecting the venue, the village and Solè Rototom Beach, our beach bar on the Gurugú beach.

There are **bike rentals** to move from the venue to wherever you want.



CASHLESS

The cashless wristband - redeemable for your ticket at the box office - will be the means of payment for your purchases at Rototom Sunsplash.

You will be able to top it up at any of the points set up in the venue, and if you do it during the pre-sale you will get 10 euros extra if you top up 100 euros and 5 euros if you top up 50 euros. If you do not wish to use this payment method,

you can use your credit card and, exceptionally and in stands that do not have it, you can pay in cash.



RESPECT POINT AND **MEDICAL ASSISTANCE**

Active every day, the Respect Point is the information point to prevent and intervene in cases where the rights of any person are violated during the festival.

Ambulances and specialised medical care are available 24 hours a day, both in the venue and in the campsite.

LOCKERS AND MOBILE CHARGING

Mobile Locker offers you lockers of different sizes and prices to store your personal belongings and to charge your mobile devices safely. You can leave your belongings in the lockers at the Entrance or at the Festival Campsite.



Flamenco salutes Bob Marley

The musical fusion of the Rototom Sunsplash goes one step further and adds a unique and unprecedented show in the history of the festival: 'El mundo flamenco saluda a Bob Marley'. Conceived by the musician Israel Suárez 'El Piraña', one of the most renowned cajón players in the world of cante jondo, after a trip to Jamaica "that opened the doors for me to get closer to Bob Marley's music than I could have ever imagined", the project will bring together on the Main Stage Alana Sinkëy, 'El Piraña', Josemi Carmona, Álex Conde, Noemí Humanes, Josue Ronkío y Juan Carmona Jr, with the special collaboration of Kiki Morente. The international reggae festival will be the epicentre of this initiatory journey, which sets itself the challenge of "singing Marley's songs from flamenco and in Marley's language". It will be the show's world premiere on August 22.






This year, in collaboration with the company Tuawa, the water supply will be available in all the bars of the venue. We will also install two water points in the camping area, where there will also be 10 fountains to refill your glass through the cashless bracelet.



ties with l'Aurora to continue saving lives

All proceeds from the cups will go to the non-profit organisation L'Aurora-Grup de Suport which, from its base in the port of Burriana (Castelló), provides support to NGO boats rescuing migrants in the Mediterranean.

As in previous editions, the reusable cup can be obtained when ordering your drink at the different bars of the festival, and deposited as a donation in the containers installed for this purpose at various points on the site.

bringing the Rototom essence to the prison population

After the end-of-course event held Thursday, 22 June, Rototom Sunsplash will once again weave ties with the prison population in the Castellón I penitentiary centre with the programming of three sessions on 17, 18 and 21 August, in the middle of the festival, with guest artists from our 'United for Peace' edition.

we repeat our collaboration with the Castellón Food Bank

With the challenge of continuing to transform the food donation system, digitalising it and thus favouring the social integration of people who receive food aid, in this edition of 'United for Peace' we maintain our collaboration with the Food Bank through the M21 Foundation, whose team will be responsible for promoting the project among the public and detailing the ways of collaboration through the totem installed at the venue. This year, for every €5 given, festival goers will be able to participate in a draw for two double tickets for Rototom Sunsplash 2024. The initiative will be complemented with the collection of non-perishable food in the festival's bars and restaurants after the festival closes.
